

“Tabunka Free School Yokohama” Multicultural Free School Yokohama 2020

1. Course outline

This is a preparatory course for the entrance exam for Japanese high school (*Koko*).

It covers three subjects: Japanese, Mathematics and English.

2. The course is intended for students who

- 1) came to Japan after graduating from junior high school (or completed 9 years of education) in their own country and who wish to enter a Japanese high school,
- 2) have graduated from Japanese junior high school and are preparing for the Japanese high school entrance examination, and
- 3) attend night classes of junior high school in Japan and who wish to enter a Japanese high school.

It starts on Monday, June 1, 2020.

Days: Monday, Tuesday and Thursday

Class hours: 10:00 – 16:30 (5 classes each day)

※ There will be no classes on national holidays.

Tuition: ¥30,000 / month

(There will be an additional charge for class materials.)
